

Marketplace Theology Concentration

Regent College is an international centre for vocational integration and spiritual formation. In the Marketplace Theology concentration, students focus on expressing the Christian faith within the context of societal roles and occupations. The Field Immersion component (APPL 692) can be arranged to be done in a local workplace or church setting. Regular faculty resources are complemented by Faculty Associates friends of the College currently serving in various societal careers who assist faculty and students in working on integrational issues.

Note: In the MCS Marketplace Theology concentration, the Field Immersion requirement (APPL 692) can be done either in a marketplace or church setting. This involves an 8-month internship, normally in the Fall and Winter terms. Students register for 1.5 credits in two successive terms, and they must submit a Field Immersion Contract with their course registration form.
