

ACADEMIC ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Regent College offers a limited number of Academic Scholarships to outstanding new students each year. These scholarships cover from one half to the full cost of tuition for one year of study to a maximum of 30 credits. Before being considered for this scholarship, students must be officially admitted into a graduate program of studies at Regent. Only admitted students will receive any scholarships. If you have not applied for admission, please contact the Admissions Office. **Note that applications for both admission and financial aid may be submitted at the same time.**

Criteria considered in selecting recipients for an Academic Scholarship are:

- Academic achievement: a minimum of 3.8 Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale.
- Strong standing against class average.
- Strong goals compatible with the mission statement of Regent College.
- Two excellent Academic references: one referee should be a Department Head of Faculty.

In addition to the Academic Scholarship Application form, students must also complete a personal statement of their goals for the future and demonstrate how studying at Regent College will help them to achieve these goals. This statement should be a maximum of two pages. The Financial Aid Committee must receive the application form and the personal statement before **March 1st** for studies beginning in the Fall Term (September) or **August 1st** for studies beginning in the Winter Term (January) of the upcoming year. Students will be informed of the results of the Financial Aid Committee meeting by the end of April for those beginning in the Fall term, and September for those beginning in the Winter term.
