

## MARKETPLACE-AS-A-CALLING APPLICATION

A new endowment award has been created. The scholarship is available beginning with the Winter 2008 term and will be awarded to the student most closely qualified by the following criteria:

- The scholarship shall be awarded to a student in good standing at Regent College and eligible for scholarship/bursary funding.
- The scholarship shall be awarded to an individual who has taken a year or more away from his/her (business/marketplace) career in order to study at Regent with the intent of returning to his/her vocation.
- The scholarship shall be awarded to a student with proven financial need.

Students must maintain a minimum of **9 on-campus credit hours** in each term they receive an award. Failure to do so will result in forfeiting some or the entire award. Note that courses taken for audit, by audio correspondence, and courses taken at other institutions are not counted towards meeting the 9 credit hour requirement.

Bursary/Scholarship awards are for tuition expenses only. Funds will be credited to each recipient's student account in the Winter term on the day that fees are due.

Students who receive a *credit* tuition benefit (i.e., Spousal 50% Credit Benefit, Parachurch 50% Credit Benefit, or an Employee 100% Credit Benefit) and students on probation are not eligible to receive a bursary/scholarship. This restriction does not apply, however, to students who are receiving an *audit* tuition benefit (e.g., Spousal 100% Audit Benefit).

*Complete the following application carefully and submit it by December 14, 2007. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Contact the Financial Aid Officer with any questions or concerns. (Note: This scholarship will be applied for using the General Bursary and Scholarship application form beginning with the Fall 2008 term).*

**All dollar amounts must be given in Canadian funds.**

- (i) A brief description of your work/ministry experience, your plans for the future, and your reasons for studying at Regent College. Be sure to include how you meet the requirements for this award.
