Stay Connected

- **Alumni webpages**—on the main Regent website. These open webpages outline benefits & services including Leaving Regent materials, alumni event listings, faculty travel, job board, alumni authors and bloggers and more.
- **Alumni Mosaic**—your online alum directory & news website. Use this secure directory to locate/contact fellow classmates, catch some current news or themed articles by fellow alums—check out articles under Career & Life Transitions. Regent faculty often check this directory when they travel, so keep your profile page updated with current contact details, news and images.

Stay Informed

- **Mosaic eNews**—the monthly alumni e-newsletter that seeks to focus on our alums ‘beyond the green roof’ by providing alumni profiles, links to resources such as Regent Audio downloads, regional events & faculty travel, news and items of interest to our global alumni community.
- **Regent Audio & Regent Radio**—helpful resources are available for download at these websites. Make sure to check out the featured downloads on Mosaic eNews.
- **CRUX**—as a graduation gift you receive a free one-year subscription to Regent’s journal—four editions beginning with Summer 2010 edition. After a year you may renew at a discounted rate.
- **The Regent World**—this print newsletter is published and mailed to alumni three times a year (except to those still registered as current students in Vancouver).
- **Alumni Seat Sales**—audit a class for 50% off (unrestricted courses only). The class preview for Summer 2011 is now available.
- **Regent eNews**—subscribe on the Regent homepage to this periodic e-newsletter that features on campus lectures, special events, discounts & promotions.

Stay Involved

- **Alums are among our best recruiters**—so consider your spheres of influence and recommend Regent to those who may benefit from some time spent here—either in full or part time studies, summer school or conferences.
- **Your feedback is highly valued**—so be involved when asked to participate in user surveys, focus groups, and other evaluation tools.
