Student Contract DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES

Regent College is a community of people who have come together for study, worship and personal growth. This community is identified by its commitment to Jesus Christ and to the Scriptures which make him known. Its will is that each of its members lead an exemplary and honourable life, consistent with and faithful to this revelation. So it is that we seek to love, honour, serve, guide and, where we have failed, to seek to make and be made right with one another. The purpose of the following contract is to identify policies adhered to by each member of the Regent Community and to reinforce the importance of trust and integrity within our community.

Fees

The following fees are quoted in Canadian dollars. If you wish to pay in US currency, please contact the College for the current exchange rate. Fees are payable by cash, cheque, money order or credit card (Visa or MasterCard).

1. **Tuition fees** from April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013: Cost is \$440 per credit hour; \$300 per audit hour.
2. **Service Fees** (non-refundable): \$35 registration fee; \$25 drop fee; \$20 dishonoured cheque fee; a \$50 late payment fee will be assessed on any outstanding balance the first overdue month, and then interest will be charged each month thereafter at a rate of 8.5% per annum.
3. **Student Fees:** Fall and Winter term students taking only Distance Education courses are not subject to Student Fees; however, they may choose to opt in if they are registering for 3 or more credit/audit hours. Students who are taking a Distance Education course in the same term that they are taking an on-campus course will be subject to Student Fees provided their total credit hours are 3 or more. Please see the current Academic Catalogue and Student Contract for on-campus courses for more information. Summer term students please see the Student Contract for on-campus courses for more information.

Course Change and Refund Policies

Students may change courses by submitting a Course Change Form with a \$25 course drop fee. (i) Deadline to receive a 100% refund for dropping a course, reducing the number of credit hours in a variable credit course or changing from credit to audit, is two weeks from the course start date (see below). (ii) Deadline to receive a 75% refund for dropping a course, reducing the number of credits in a variable credit course, or changing from credit to audit, is four weeks from the course start date. No refunds are available after this date. (iii) Deadline for dropping a course, reducing the number of credits in a variable credit course, or changing from credit to audit, is eight weeks from the course start date.

*All course materials must be returned in original condition before a drop or refund is approved.

Due Dates and Academic Policies

1. Course start dates and Due Dates will be determined by the following: (i) Course start dates are set as two weeks from when we process your registration and send out or make available the course material, (ii) Your Due Date is six months from your course start date.
2. Please consult the *Regent College Prospectus and Academic Catalogue* for admissions policies, program requirements, program duration, appeals, rules of conduct and dismissal as well as other academic policies.
3. Please consult the Student Handbook for general questions on how to complete your course and for orientation on our procedures.
