

Friends of Regent College Canada Trust - Bursary

Purpose:

This fund was initiated by the trustees of the Friends of Regent College Canada Trust (the "UK Trust") for the purpose of recruiting one or more students from England, Wales, Scotland and/or Northern Ireland and assisting with the cost of attending Regent College in Vancouver, Canada.

Designation and Special Instructions:

A bursary (or bursaries) shall be awarded annually, dependent on funding, according to the guidelines laid out below. In the event that a suitable candidate(s) is not found, the funds shall be awarded to a current student from the UK in good standing at Regent College.

- 1) The bursary shall be awarded to a resident from the UK who is a student accepted to Regent College with good standing from their previous school.
- 2) The bursary shall be awarded taking into account the following criteria: academic achievement, leadership experience, and proven financial need.
- 3) Candidates must indicate a clear commitment to return to the UK following the completion of their studies at Regent.

Advertisement

The Friends of Regent College Canada Trust Bursary will be communicated at the discretion of Regent College Admissions Counsellors to candidates they deem to fit the above criteria. Candidates may be asked to provide supplemental documentation showing evidence of the criteria above. The Friends of Regent College Canada Trust Bursary will also be advertised on the Friends of Regent College Canada Trust website. This task will be the responsibility of the Communications Team and Development Office.

Implementation:

The distribution and stewardship of The Friends of Regent College Canada Trust will be completed by the required departments at Regent College: the Development Office, the Admissions Department, and the Financial Aid Officer.

Gifts that are received by the UK Trust will be communicated to the Development Office. The Development Office will be responsible for the stewardship of these gifts.

The Friends of Regent College Canada Trust bursary will be granted at the discretion of the Admissions Department of Regent College to a suitable candidate(s). The Financial Aid Officer will be responsible for distributing the funds into the student account(s) once the student has arrived and registered for classes.

Disclosure:

Once the recipient(s) are confirmed, Regent College will be responsible for obtaining the 'Thank You Letter and Bio', which will contain information on the awardee(s) as well as a photo of the recipient(s). This letter will be forwarded to the donor(s) in order to provide them with information on how their scholarship is being used as well as establishing a connection between donor and awardee.

Regent College will also post on the Trust website a photo and bio of the award recipient, so that Regent alumni in the UK can join in supporting these students. This will be the responsibility of the Development Office.
