## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Welcome to New Testament Greek. The purpose of this course is to provide an introduction to the basic elements of Greek grammar and vocabulary as a foundation for reading and interpreting the Greek New Testament. Regrettably, as much as we intend otherwise, memorization does play a key part in the learning process, particularly with regard to vocabulary and word-form paradigms.

The course closely follows the outline of Mounce's *Basics of Biblical Greek* (4<sup>th</sup> edition), with some modifications. Generally, we cover one chapter per day. A detailed schedule will be provided on the first day of class.

Although this sort of an intensive course is challenging, there are great rewards. We will experience the richness of heeding Luther's charge: "...as we value the gospel, let us zealously hold to the languages." At the end of seven weeks, you will have made huge strides to read the New Testament in its original language!
