BIBL 506: A Narrative Approach to the Gospels and Acts

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Viewing the four Gospels and the book of Acts through a narrative lens suggests fresh interpretative domains for consideration. These include exploration of an author's plotting, characterization, point of view, intertextual emphases, and narrative theologizing. In this course, we will study the first five books of the New Testament with an eye toward their narrative contours and design. Attention will be given to narrative-exegetical skill development, appreciation for the literary artistry of these narratives, and holistic engagement with their theological messages.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon the successful completion of this course, students should have a clearer understanding of:

- 1. Analyze each of the four Gospels and Acts with a view to their narrative shaping.
- 2. Employ concepts of characterization and point of view to evaluate the evangelists' narrative purposes.
- 3. Critically engage course readings to develop interpretive practices that are sensitive to narrative elements of the Gospels and Acts.
